Cultural Identity Expression: The Bridge Between Your Story and History

Each of us carries a story shaped by culture, ancestry and lived experience. When we express who we are, we contribute to a much larger historical narrative. This presentation explores the powerful connections between cultural identity, personal expression and history. Through reflection, storytelling and dialogue, participants will examine how individual journeys are rooted in broader cultural legacies, and how these identities influence the way we engage with the world. By understanding the bridge between personal and collective history, attendees will gain tools to support inclusive spaces where diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging (DEIB) are not just values but lived experiences. Participants will have the opportunity to approach DEIB topics through the lens of cultural narratives and connection.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Participants will be able to:

- Identify elements of cultural identity, recognize how personal expression connects to broader historical and cultural narratives, and reflect on the ways individual stories contribute to collective history and community understanding.
- Describe how cultural identity and self-expression shape perspectives, and apply practices that lead to inclusive dialogue by reviewing the historical roots and contemporary relevance of diverse cultural experiences.
- Evaluate how identity and personal narratives inform principles of diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging (DEIB), and learn how honoring these stories can foster more empathetic, respectful and inclusive environments.
